□ Art Angels Classes in the Schools

Art Angels gave two workshops for children ages 6-12 on Friday, July 27, at the Wilbur May Museum. For the morning session, there were 41 children participating, with 5 instructors and 6 helpers. Nancy reported that we received a grant from Nevada Arts Council for \$4,207 to cover Art Angels supplies, as well as some money for Artist Demos, travel, rental space, marketing, and office materials, (including software and newsletter). Nancy passed out a break out of the amount for each category (based on percentage of the \$7,500 request). We have to match all funds we receive from Nevada Arts Council.
