#### **RULES FOR ALL CHALLENGES:**

Entries will not be accepted unless they meet the following Challenge rules exactly - NO EXCEPTIONS

- 1. Do not sign your painting.
- 2. Entries must fit the theme.
- 3. Entries must be matted (they do not need to be framed).
- 4. Entries may only be submitted into one Challenge. You may not enter a challenge painting into a second Challenge, even if it fits the theme.
- 5. Entries must be new, having been painted specifically for the Challenge.
- 6. Entries cannot have been shown in an exhibit prior to the Challenge.

## **January Demo**



So a successful event!

The Art Angels Holiday Workshop had 50 registrants, plus 15 on the waiting list; a couple people called to cancel and a few did not show up, but we accommodated a total of 40 children, all of whom created beautiful artwork and had a great time! We had eight tables of instruction, so I am most grateful to instructors **Eva Nichols, Cheryl Keaveney, Alicia Cobb, Ronnie Rector, Mary Ann Quaglieri, Linda James, and Sally Shaw** (and me) and to helpers **J. R. Stafford, Kathy Martin, Bess Inouye, Brooke Cobb, Gracie Allen, and George Baba,** who kept emptying & refilling water containers, blow-dried paintings, and encouraged the children! We also received \$45 in tips! The Evaluation Forms were resurrected for this workshop, but were not prominently displayed, so only four parents filled them out—but all four were so enthusiastic they signed up their children for the next Art Angels Workshop in May, and two others on the Waiting List for the Holiday Workshop also signed up, for a total of 15 children registered to date! 
